



2021 Double Eagle Invitational Tournament Format & Rules

A. Two-man teams.

B. Stableford scoring is applied as follows:

Bogey	1 Point
Par	2 Points
Birdie	3 Points
Eagle	4 Points
Double Eagle	6 Points

C. Team Handicap: Each player's individual index is added together, divided by 2 and applied to the Snowmass index for your initial Stableford quota. Handicaps will be checked and adjustments made by the tournament committee if deemed necessary. The decision of the committee is final with no appeals.

D. Formats:

1. Day One score based on a "Modified Florida Scramble". Each player must hit 8 (eight) tee shots. Tee shots must be recorded. After the tee shot has been hit, go to the drive selected. The player not hitting the tee shot selected will then place his ball in play. From that point hit two second shots, pick the best one and hit two shots from that point until you have holed-out. Both balls may be improved anywhere in play within one club length from the ball selected not closer to the hole. The character of the lie must remain the same. If you are in the rough, stay in the rough...same for sand traps. If you are not on the green you cannot use a club length to get on the green.
2. Day two score is based on "Best Ball". Each player plays his own ball throughout the hole and the better score of the two balls is used. Play the ball flat ... no improving the ball.
3. Day three score is based on the score of both balls. This year, on the par 4's and par 5's, we will use a select drive format. On the par 4 and 5's, both players hit their tee shots. Select the best drive and the other player DROPS, (NOT PLACES) his ball within 1 club length of his partner's ball, no closer to the hole. The character of the lie cannot be changed, if you are in the rough, the dropped ball must stay in the rough. Each player then plays his own ball through the hole. Both balls count. If you cannot make bogey, pick-up. Zero points for double bogey so pick up when necessary...play the ball flat ... no improving the ball.

Double Eagle Tournament Rules

1. Fourteen club limit is waived.
2. We are playing blue tees for the tournament. Those that are 65 years or older may play from the whites.
3. The embedded ball rule is in effect.
4. No relief shall be provided from small trees unless marked or staked.
5. Play the ball flat/down unless in scramble format.
6. Each player will have 1 mulligan per day which they can use to replace any shot. Once declared, the player must use the mulligan.
7. Penalty shots applied for slow play. A member of the golf club staff will determine if a penalty is in order. His decision is final! You must keep up with the group in front of you.
8. If lines are not definable, then the hazard is determined by the water's edge.
9. In case of a tie for 1st place after three days (I can't believe this is possible), we will have a sudden death play-off. If this is not practical, we will have a scorecard playoff beginning on a hole selected by draw.
